I do the editing in Adobe InDesign. Here I make the interactive content page, links, videos etc.



The e-pub is converted to .azw3 or .mobi format via an online converter to make the file readable on Amazon Kindles





The file is then exported to e-pub format. There's still work to do, so I import the file to an XML editor to work in details with the StyleSheet (CCS).

- use footnotes on pages (they can be placed in the end of the file if wanted)
- use colored texboxes like this.
  ebooks don't support that, it will have to be converted to graphic.
