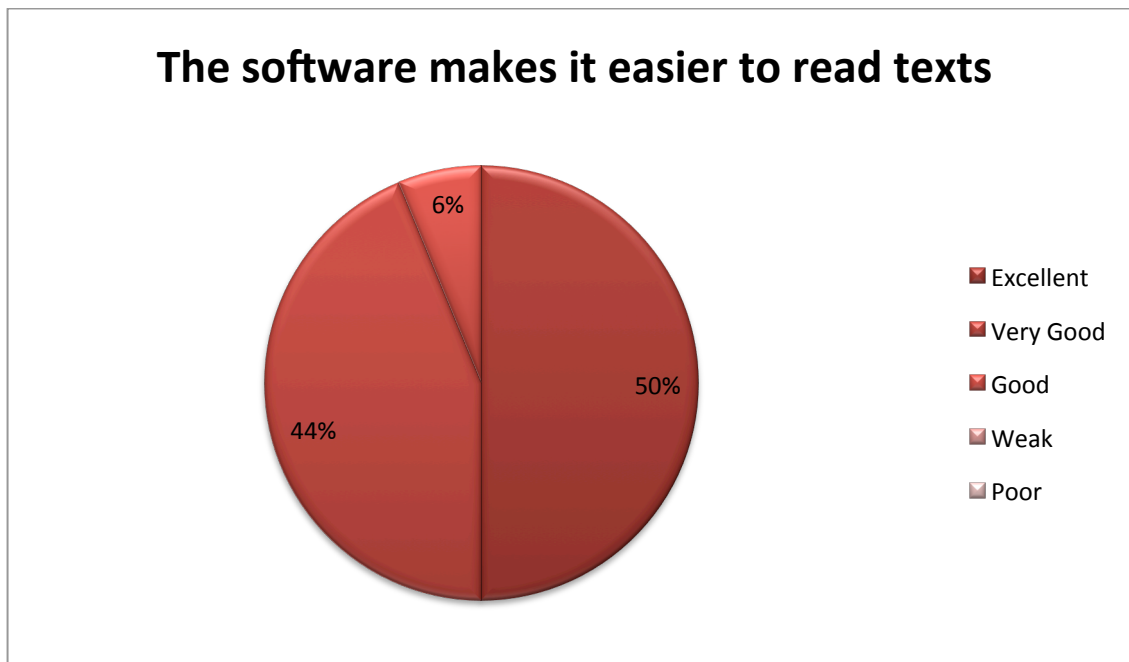
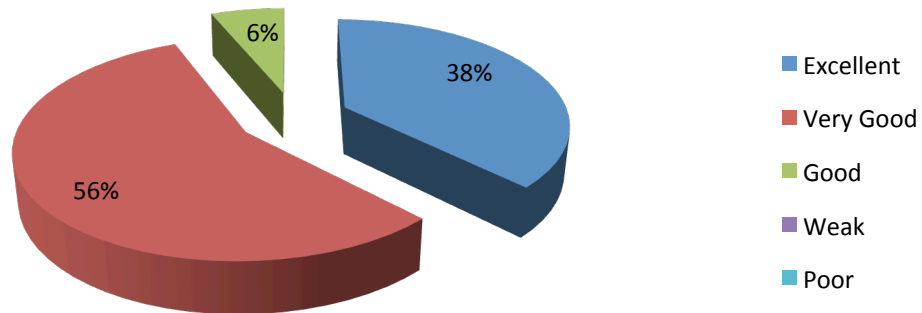

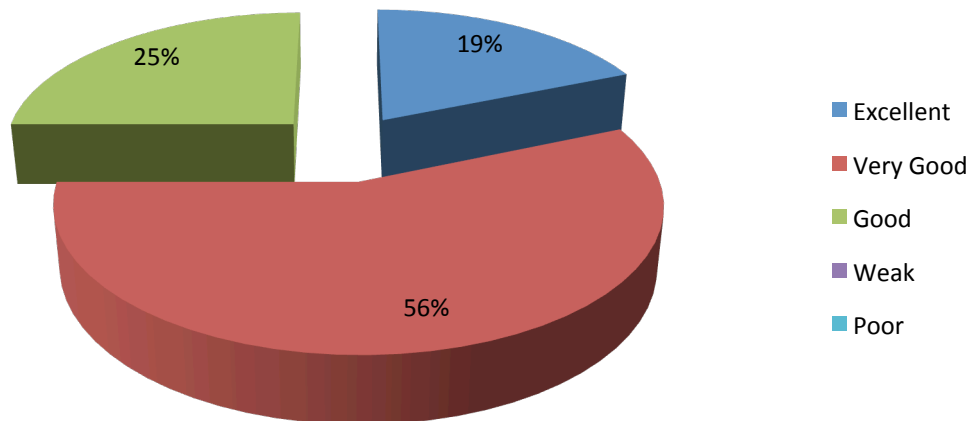
The results are:
