Subject relevance: Public Services

Characters: Interviewee < A > Interviewer < B >

A: Good morning. I'm here for the job you have posted in the local newspaper, *Curierul Argeşean*.

- B: Good morning. Sit down please.
- A: Thank you.
- B: What is your name, please?
- A: I'm Popescu Ion.
- B: OK. I have here your CV. Let me have a look on it.

Yes, I can see that you were an eminent student and you have attended several training courses. I'm really impressed.

- A: Thank you.
- B: Let's see. Why do you want this job?

Subject relevance: Catering and Tourism

Characters: Customer < C > Restaurant employee < RE >

- RE: Good evening. Casa Românească Restaurant.
- C: Good evening. I would like to order three menus, specialty of the house.
- RE: OK. Would you like medium, large or regular size for all your menu dishes?
- C: Regular size, please.
- RE: What kind of *flavours* do you want them to be?
- C: I would like two salads with cheese and a vegetarian soup. What kind of vegetarian soups do you have?
- RE: We have soup with mushrooms, with ...
- C: No, I hate mushrooms.
- RE: OK. Then we have soup with tomatoes, onion, pepper, and olives...
- C: This sounds good. I will have this one.
- RE: OK. Would you like some extra dressing?
- C: Yes, please. Is that included in the cost of the salad or do I have to pay extra money?
