Many thanks for your lesson material. I like the practical approach that surely will motivate your students with craft relevant materials.

May I suggest that you create an overall task scenario headline that can wrap up the different parts? I have on many occasions had success with such a “wrapper” , in your task it could be something like: Your task is to prepare yourselves for introducing the workshop area and safety equipment to a visiting non-Danish speaking apprentice. This should of course be followed by a general outline of the content (pre-task, main task, and post-task) so the students know what to expect.

I also like your exercise ideas, you write that you would like / need to know more about how to make the exercises “live”, i.e. online. Your exercises can easily be made live with the help of the software “Hot Potatoes”

The issue of Hot Potatoes was also raised by Chelo, so may I suggest that you and Chelo (and perhaps also Öznur?) start working through the “Hot Potatoes” tasks parallel with these tasks?
